## **Overview of the mission:**

The LuxYGT will report to the Head of the Industrial Policy and Space Economy Division. The Industrial Policy and Space Economy Division includes two main teams: the Industrial Policy and the Space Economy teams.

The Space Economy team is in charge of:

- Measuring the space economy
- Assessing the socio-economic impacts of space activities
- Developing partnerships to consolidate the required methodologies (with OECD, Eurostat, etc.)

It is working in close cooperation with ESA's Programme Directorates.

## Overview of the field of activity proposed:

The LuxYGT will:

- Support the analysis of the socio-economic impacts of space activities and the socio-economic studies
- Support studies on various topics related to space economy
- Support the preparation of the ESA's yearly Space Economy Report
- Support the communication of the Space Economy team (website, social media)
- Support the work of the European Centre of Space Economy and Commerce (ECSECO)
