Overview of the mission:

The Office uses a variety of strategic foresight methodologies to assess current trends in society, geostrategy, politics, the environment, economy, law, technology, and values to anticipate potential change and disruption, identify threats and opportunities, and facilitate sound decision making at the Agency.

Overview of the field of activity proposed:

As a LuxYGT, you will be involved in a variety of strategic foresight activities, ranging from horizon scanning to scenario planning and interdisciplinary studies in a broad range of areas and sectors. These activities will assist the Agency's global preparedness, and also support specific projects, such as human and robotic exploration, innovation, the fight against climate change, etc.

A very broad range of fields will be considered as we value all disciplines. An interdisciplinary education and atypical background would be a strong asset.
